Shingle Bank – Extending beyond Minehead Pier

A shingle bank has built up at the entrance to Minehead harbour causing an underwater obstruction.

The shingle is approximately 2.5m in height and extends in a SE'ly to S'ly direction from the seaward end of the pier for approximately 20m.

All users and visitors to the harbour should navigate with caution and allow sufficient clearance over or around the shingle bank.

The shape and size of the bank is changing with tidal influence.
