Town and Country Planning General Development Orders 1973 to 1974

Milverton(No. 1) Article 4 Direction 1977

WHEREAS the Taunton Deane Borough Council being the appropriate local planning authority within the meaning of Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973, as amended, for the Taunton Deane Borough are satisfied that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out within the area shown edged black on the plan annexed hereto unless permission therefor is granted on application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973, as amended.

AND WHEREAS the Council are further of the opinion that development of the said description would constitute a threat to the amenities of their area and that the provisions of paragraph 3 (b) of the said Article should apply to this direction.

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by the said Article 4 hereby direct that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development in the said area of the description set out in the schedule hereto.

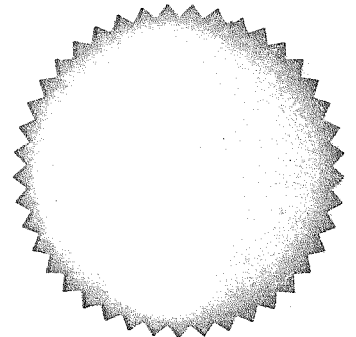
THIS DIRECTION is made in pursuance of the provisions of paragraph 3(b) of the said Article 4 and shall remain in force until the 15th day of September, 1977 (being six months from the date of this direction) and will then expire unless it has been approved by the Secretary of State for the Environment before that date.

SCHEDULE

The painting of external walls of un-painted brick or un-painted natural stone of any building within the area shown edged black on the plan annexed hereto being development comprised within Class 11(3) referred to in the First Schedule to the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1973 and not being development comprised within any other Class.
